- Motivate: Are there applications? Is it theoretically interesting? Put your topic in context.
- Is there reading and/or problems for this seminar that relate to your presentation? Tell us.
- At start: Clearly indicate what the goal of your presentation is
- At end: Emphasize what you have taught us and the take-home importance/meaning
- Skip excessive algebra
- Build in interactivity. E.g. pose a question to listeners, ask them to walk through an example with you?
